
SUBJECT: Notification of Asbestos Related Renovation Activities
July 6, 2010 to July 15, 2010

In accordance with the requirements of federal and state regulations, the school must notify appropriate, Parent Teacher Organizations, parents, and school employees prior to commencement of renovation activities, which require the removal or disturbance of asbestos-containing materials. As part of the carpet and tile removal project at Spring Grove Elementary School, some asbestos-containing materials will be removed during the renovation.

All work activities will be performed by an Illinois Department of Public Health licensed asbestos abatement contractor. To ensure that work activities are performed in strict accordance with applicable federal, state, and local regulations, we have retained the services of a professional environmental services firm to manage the performance of the overall project. Work activities will be performed in strict accordance with applicable regulations, utilizing state of the art work practices and engineering controls. Access to the work area will be restricted for the duration of the project. Air monitoring will be performed on a daily basis, and at the conclusion of the project to ensure that air quality standards have been met and maintained.

We appreciate your cooperation, and apologize about any inconvenience these renovation activities may cause you. If you should have any questions regarding this project, I will be available to answer any questions that you may have.
